Natural stone for landscape & drainage

RIVER ROCK MATERIALS

River rock is naturally rounded over time by water, with textured surfaces and color variation that can include white, gray, tan, brown, and deep red.

ODG stocks pea gravel through oversize boulders.

Pea Gravel**3/8" (gray, tan, red, brown mix)**

Small, smooth-rounded river rock — the most popular decorative gravel for residential use. Natural color variation gives beds, paths, and playgrounds a soft, organic look.

Screened River Rock**3/8" · ½" · 1" · 1½" · 2" · #57**

Uniform-sized river rock screened to a specific range. Used in landscaping, decoration, drainage, and construction applications depending on size.

Pipe bedding (#57)

Pit Run River Rock

A naturally occurring, unscreened mix of sand, soil, and river rock. Contains a range of sizes and fines. Less consistent than screened product but may suit informal fill and drainage needs.

Large, rounded river stones used for accent boulders, dry creek bed features, and erosion-control applications where visual presence matters as much as function.

Dry Creek Bed

Combine Oversize (6"-12") along the channel edges, Screened 2" for the main bed, and Pea Gravel for the fringes to create a naturalistic dry creek that manages stormwater visually.



Dog Run

Pea gravel is the go-to surface for dog runs — it drains well, is easy to clean, and won't trap odors the way mulch does. Use a 3-4" depth on a compacted base.



Drainage Behind Retaining Walls

Screened River Rock (1"-2") backfilled behind block retaining walls allows water to drain freely and relieves hydrostatic pressure.



Decorative Ground Cover

River rock ground cover eliminates mowing, suppresses weeds, and stays in place better than mulch. Pair with landscape fabric and edging for a clean, low-maintenance look.

Pro Tips Before You Order

River rock does not compact

Unlike road base, river rock is open-graded and stays loose. It provides excellent drainage but is not suitable as a structural base material.

Size affects drainage rate

Larger stone drains faster. Use 1"-2" screened rock for drainage behind walls and in French drains. Pea gravel is decorative but drains more slowly.
