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COMMERCIAL HAULING SERVICES

Commercial Material Delivery

High-volume road base, fill, aggregate, and specialty material supply dispatched from Cibolo, TX. Dedicated truck runs available for sites needing continuous material flow.

Pre-scheduled material runs: once a schedule is confirmed with dispatch, material arrives without a new call each load. ODG coordinates directly with your site superintendent — no per-load communication required.

COMMERCIAL HAULING SERVICES

Excavation Spoil Export & C&D Removal

Excavation spoil export: rapid haul-off of cut, overburden, and debris. Stage spoils at an accessible pile. Quad-axle trucks can clear large volumes in a single day.

C&D debris removal: concrete rubble, asphalt millings, framing waste, and mixed C&D. Dump trucks are more cost-effective than roll-off containers for heavy, dense material. Call for a per-load rate comparison.

COMMERCIAL HAULING SERVICES

Coordinated In/Out Service

Maximize site efficiency by bringing material in and removing spoils out in the same scheduling window.

Common applications: driveway replacement (old asphalt out, new base in), foundation prep (excavation spoils out, select fill in), site grading (overburden out, road base in), retaining wall (backfill in, demo debris out).

Single call to dispatch coordinates both legs. One invoice, one point of contact.

Utility, Infrastructure & Recurring Work

Utility and infrastructure work: Select Fill and bedding sand deliveries timed to trench backfill schedules. ODG coordinates arrival windows with your crew to keep backfill operations running without material gaps.

Recurring scheduled runs: for active construction sites, ODG sets up a daily or weekly delivery schedule. Material arrives on schedule without a new call each time. Share your CPM schedule for high-volume week coordination.

PRO TIPS BEFORE YOU ORDER

Pre-qualify site access early.

Confirm gate width, haul road surface, and dump zone location before scheduling — ODG dispatch needs this to select the right truck class and plan load counts.

Share your CPM schedule for larger projects.

Knowing your high-volume days in advance lets ODG reserve truck capacity before you need it — not after you call in a crunch.
