Complete ODG Materials Reference

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Aggregates & Road Base

Limestone Spec Base (0"–3"), Flex Base, Screened Rock (3/8"–2", #57), Bull Rock, Rip Rap, Caliche. Granite Base (0"×2", 0"×3"), DG (0"–1"), Bull Rock (2"–6"), Rip Rap (6"–36"+).

Spec Base is required for city/county permitted projects. Flex Base for private driveways and non-permitted work. #57 Stone is the standard drainage aggregate for French drain installations.

Fills, Sands & Soils

Select Fill (tested sand-clay blend, city spec), Common Fill (untested, economy). Screened Topsoil (finish layer for sod/planting). Three Way Mix (topsoil + compost + sand — ideal for raised beds).

Sand options: Washed Concrete Sand (ASTM C33), Fill Sand, Cushion/Bedding/Masonry Sand. Always use Select Fill within 5 ft of structural elements — never Common Fill.

Decorative & Specialty Stone

Pea Gravel (3/8"), Screened River Rock (3/8"–2"), Oversize River Rock (3"–12"), Black Star Gravel (dark basaltic crushed stone), Decomposed Granite (0"–1"), Arizona River Rock (premium import), Landscape Boulders.

Note: river rock does not compact — use for drainage and decoration, not structural base. DG compacts to a firm, permeable surface ideal for xeriscape pathways and patios.

Organics, Mulch & Recycled

Mulch: Black, Brown, Red (dyed), Native/Undyed. Three Way Mix for raised beds. Screened Topsoil for lawn prep.

Recycled: Screened Asphalt Millings (heat-binds under Texas sun), Crushed Concrete Rock (1", 3"×5", 4"×8"), Recycled Concrete Flexbase. Recycled materials are not a substitute for Spec Base on permitted or engineered projects.
